

## **SUMMER CAMP 2018**

### **Week 1- June 4-8**

#### **MORNING**

##### **4-6 year olds**

In the Round: This session will delve into sculptural artworks. Campers will discover various ways we can create artworks in the three dimensional realm. We will explore 3D art through media like clay and paper mache, starting from relief style artworks to fully in the round sculptures. Campers will learn how artists have used sculpture throughout history and today.

##### **7-8 year olds**

Old School Is Cool (Definitely Not Digital)

Let's put modern technology aside for a week and allow our hands and imaginations guide us to push the boundaries of image making. Students will create images using simple pinhole cameras and cyanotype emulsion. Along with these photographic processes, student will also have the opportunity to use the darkroom to develop their own paper positive images, create photograms, and explore Solarization. Other projects will include making paper to construct a book in which to display our unique images.

##### **9-10 year olds**

Place: Exploring artistic connections through location. Students will explore place-based concerns such as what it means to be a desert dweller, and how architecture affects our experience of space.

##### **11-13 year olds**

Make an Impression: Patterns, Textures, and Printmaking

Campers will delve into exploring how artists create enticing patterns and prints through using different textures. We'll make our own stamps out of different materials including sponges, foam, and even objects from nature to explore the different textures we can create! We will also make texture and pattern-filled collages and mosaics using mixed media. We will look at examples of folk art and Pre-Columbian pottery at TMA to see how other artists use pattern and texture to create something unforgettable.

#### **AFTERNOON**

##### **4-6 year olds**

## Just Paper

Fold, cut, roll, glue, tear, bend, and make paper. It is one of the most basic building materials for art making, and there is little that you can't do with it. In this class we will try and see just how far we can go with a piece of paper. Students will have a chance to make their own paper, marbleize paper, learn classic origami techniques, build masks out of paper, learn some bookmaking techniques, and try many more experimental approaches that work with paper. Throughout the class we will be looking at classic traditional approaches as well as contemporary ideas. You'll never look at a piece of paper the same way again.

### **7-8 year olds**

Community: Investigating cultural and personal meaning through art. Students will build connections with their own cultural ties, and discover ways art can bring people together through communicating ideas.

### **9-10 year olds**

#### Photographers are Magicians! Make the Invisible Visible

Making or creating images is a great way to bring your imagination to life. Setting up a scene, casting characters, and building environments to photograph make it possible to communicate ideas to others. Students will construct their own images while working together, dressing up, using lighting and props, building models, and finding new locations. Students will also have the opportunity to shoot film and print in the darkroom as well as create digital images and print them with an inkjet printer.

### **11-13 year olds**

Textures of Nature: Focusing on the textures we see and find in nature, campers will be creating artworks inspired by the natural world around us. What shapes, lines, textures, colors and forms do we find in nature? Campers will put their inspiration into artworks such as prints, cyanotypes, drawings/paintings, and other art forms.

### **WEEK 5- July 9-13**

#### **MORNING**

#### **4-6 year olds**

Around the World: Get your passports! This class will take you to continents, countries, and cultures around the world. We will study different art forms and practice techniques from all over the world using many different materials such as fabric, paint, wood, and clay. Start packing your bags!

#### **7-8 year olds**

Modern Art

Go back in time to learn about Modern Art. Experiment with new styles like Pop Art, Expressionism, Abstraction, and Pointillism. Express yourself new techniques like collage, printmaking, painting, sculpture, and more. Students will channel modern artists to see things a new way and use art materials in different ways.

#### **9-10 year olds**



Exploring the Elements: Students will use the elements of art (shape, form, value, line color, space, and texture) as the foundation of their masterpieces. Artists will explore and learn about the elements through projects such as painting, drawing, mixed media, and sculpture. Artists will also have the opportunity to explore the Museum's collection and learn how to see the elements are used in various artworks on view.

### **11-13 year olds**

Storytelling and mixed media

In this class, we will explore ways to tell a story using a variety of media including bookmaking, puppetry, drama, painting, sculpture, and comic books. We will look at the stories that artists have told us through the history of art up until today.

### **AFTERNOON**

### **4-6 year olds**

Scapes: In this class we will be exploring cityscapes, seascapes, and landscapes such as forests, deserts, sunsets, sunrises and skies. We will observe many different art movements such as Realism, Expressionism, Impressionism, Cubism, Surrealism and Abstraction by exploring books in the library collection and works of art on view in the Museum's galleries. Working from life observations and our imagination we will explore many mediums: drawing, painting, printmaking, collage and sculpture. Focusing on the elements of art and the principles of design we will create our own masterpieces.

### **7-8 year olds**

Painting: The painting session will explore different kinds of paint, acrylic and watercolor, and a variety of painterly techniques. At the end of the week, camp participants will select their most successful artwork, write a label to accompany their piece of art and create a mock gallery exhibition opening which will be open to their peers.

### **9-10 year olds**

Environmental Art

In this class, students will learn about the world around them by using the environment as their inspiration. Classes will include landscape art, sketching, printmaking, and more. Students will also use repurposed materials from nature to make artworks including mosaics, paintings, and sculptures.

### **11-13 year olds**

Collage and Combination: During the week, students will explore and experiment with vibrant forms of expression through... PAPER! We will select, reorder and talk about our decisions. We will also learn about certain artists and see what they did with paper, too. Visiting a diverse array of uses, students will have the opportunity to explore freely in their practice.
